When the body of a woman is reclined backwards, or half-sitting, half lying, the brim of the pelvis is horizontal, and an imaginary straight line descending from the navel, would pass through the middle of the cavity; but in the last months of pregnancy, such a line must take its rise from the middle space between the navel and [upper/middle region of the abdomen], *Scrobiculum Cordis*,

in order to pass through the same point of the pelvis.

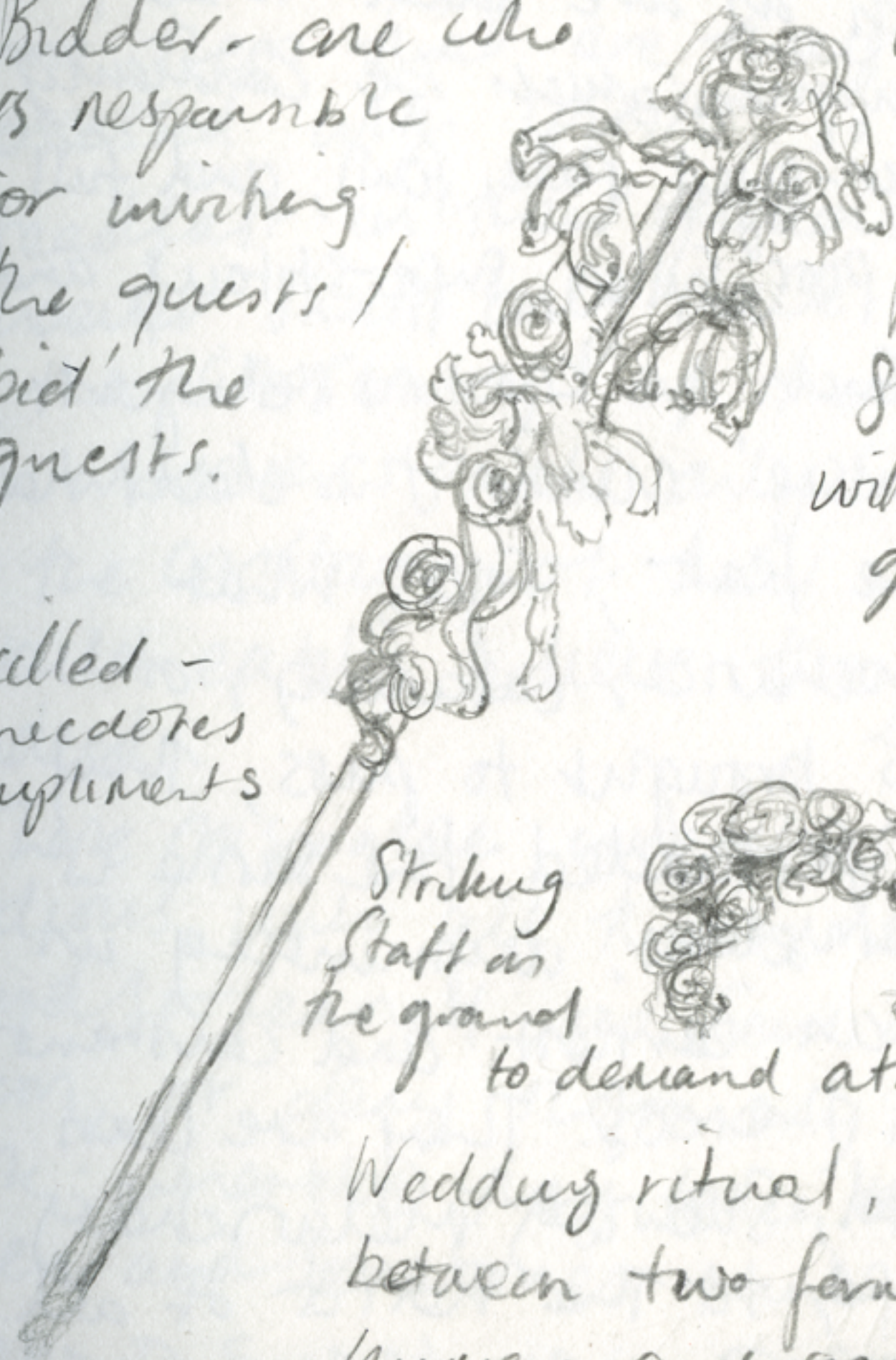

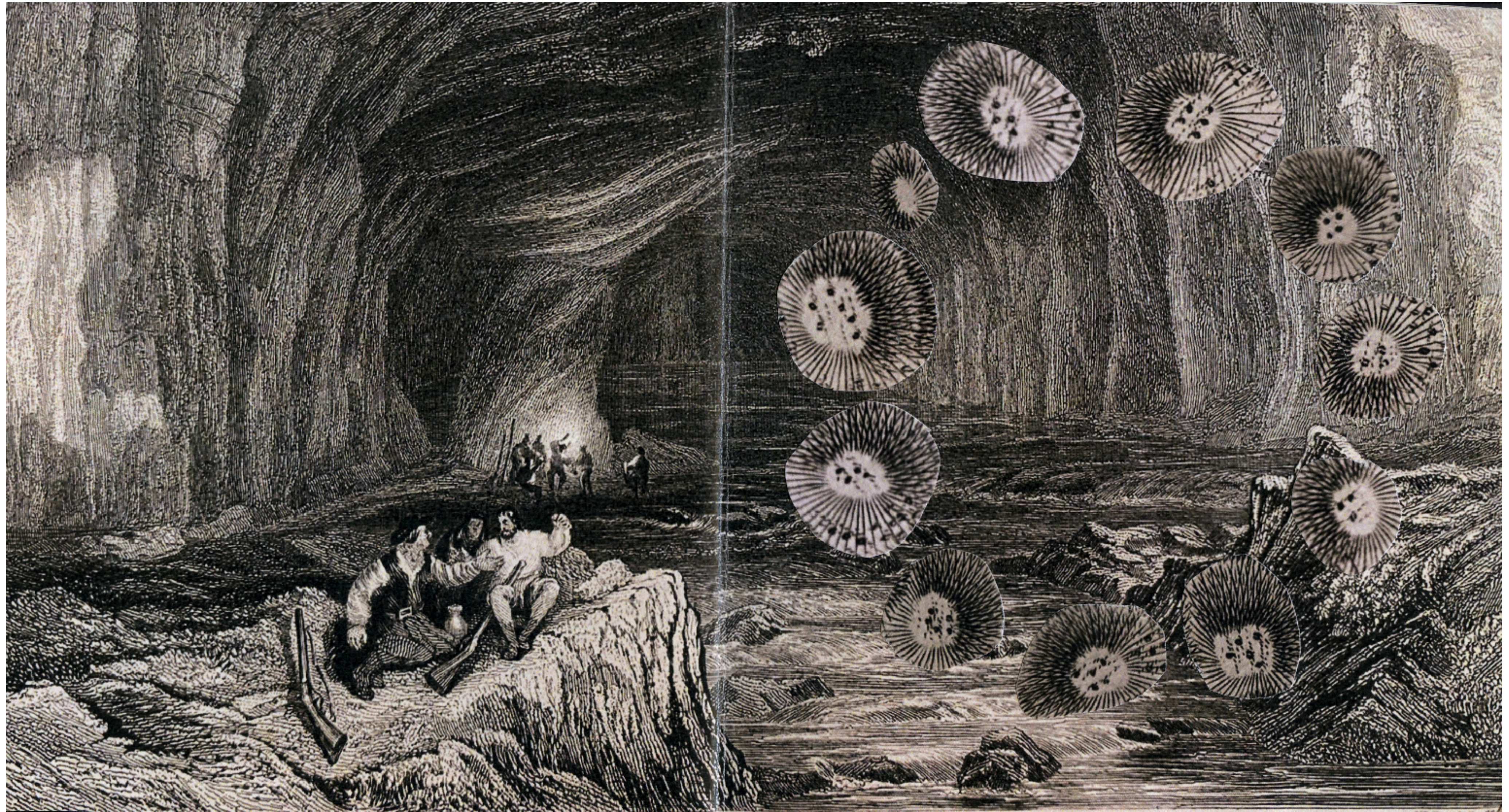

ARTHUR'S STONE, NEAR SWANSEA.

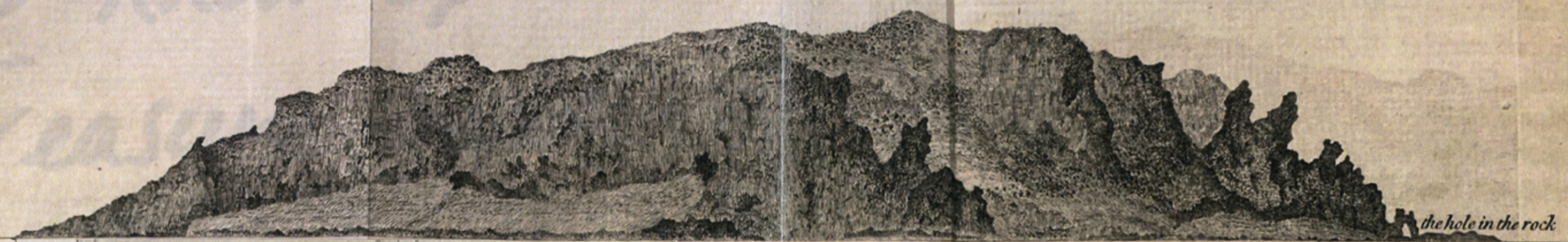

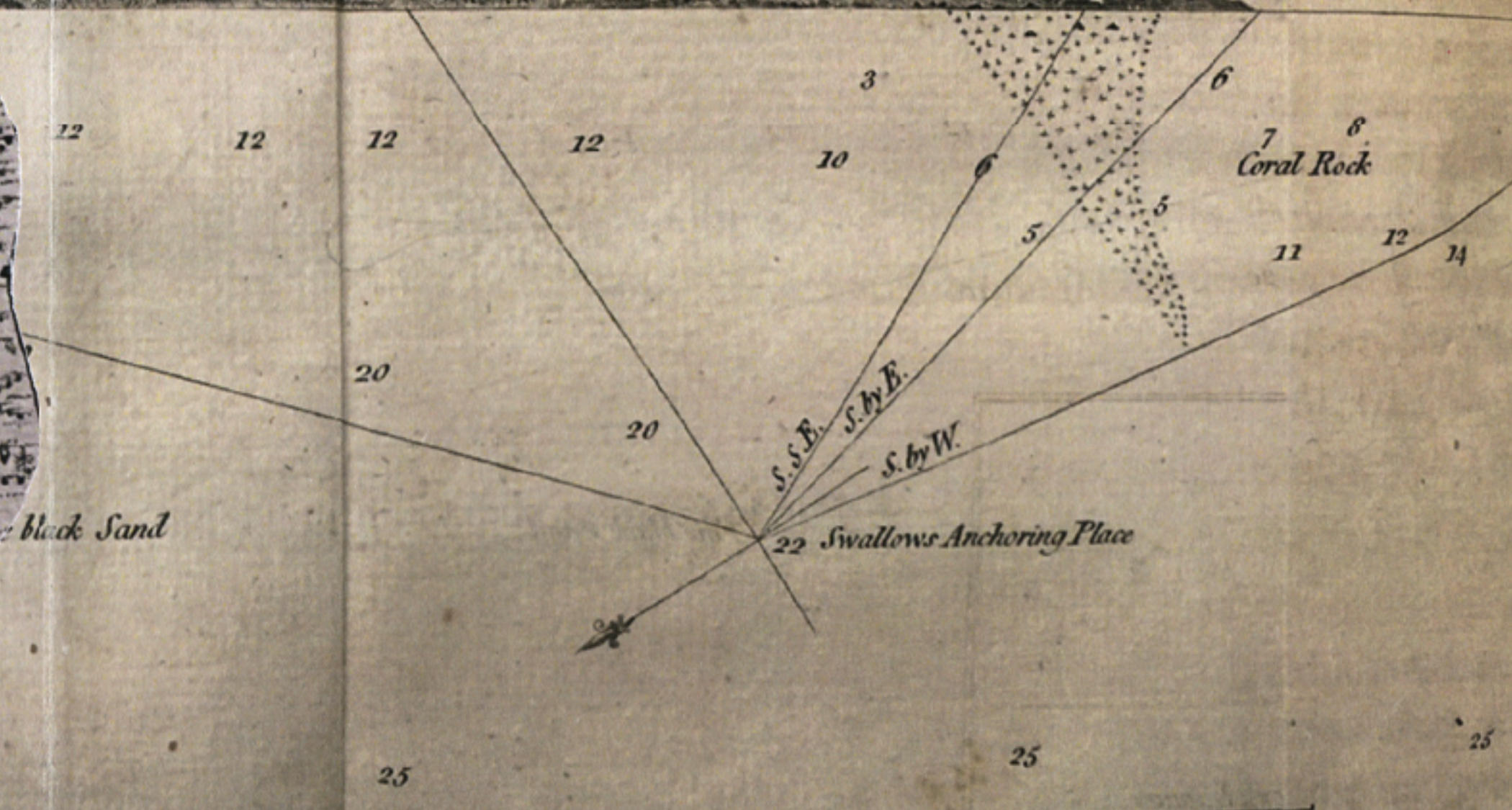


*A View of the N.W. Side of MAS-A-FUERA*

*Mas-a-Fuera bearing N.W. distant about 23 Leagues.*

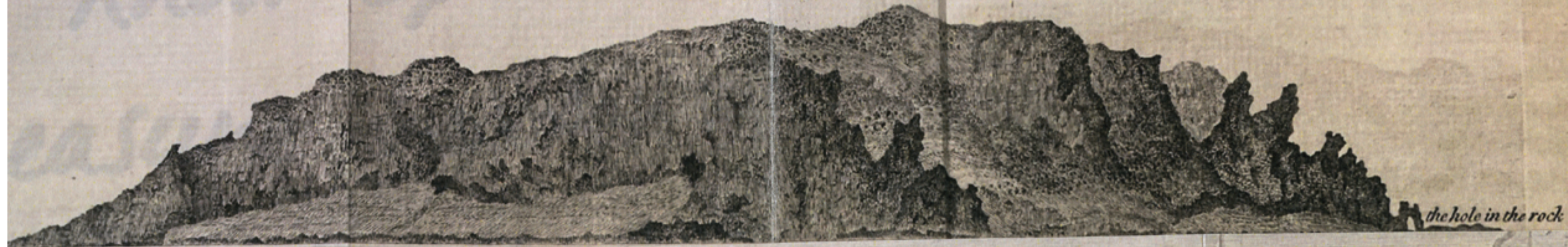


*A Scale of two Miles*
